CONCERNS

- The plan sees a prime task of ALL forests as wood products production. No exemptions for special places!
- They have not made the claim, nor the case, that the existing forest is not diverse not unhealthy nor stressed
- The resulting forest and Bellows Pipe Trail will be vastly diminished ecologically and aesthetically should this ill-advised plan be implemented
 - ① Drinking water, a specific and prime role of this forest is under eminent threat because the logging plan through DCR implementation is largely exempt from water and wetland regulation
- We object by the purposeful misrepresentation of the plan not a "Climate Smart Demonstration Forest" but rather a traditional detrimental 'logging plan' by a 'green washed' coalition
